Summary: Under general supervision, operates a variety of vehicles and motorized equipment in the construction, maintenance and repair of County roads, bridges, right of way and in the operation of the County quarry.

Distinguishing Characteristics: None.

Essential Job Functions: Essential functions, as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, may include any of the following tasks, knowledges, skills and other characteristics. The list that follows is not intended as a comprehensive list; it is intended to provide a representative summary of the major duties and responsibilities. Incumbent(s) may not be required to perform all duties listed, and may be required to perform additional, position-specific tasks.

- Operates a wide range of vehicles and motorized equipment, including graders, bulldozers, front-end loaders, backhoe, rollers, tractors and various trucks in support of various construction, repair and maintenance projects.
- Transports materials and equipment to and from job sites using various trucks.
- Operates heavy equipment in the removal of snow and ice, debris and other objects from roadways.
- Participates in field surveys for road projects.
- Provides on-site work direction and instruction to work crews as needed.
- Performs maintenance and repairs to various vehicles and equipment.
- Performs traffic control during hazardous road conditions or around work sites.
- Performs manual labor tasks as needed.
- Responds to 24/7 emergency call-outs as required.
- Performs related work as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Required Knowledge and Skills:

- Knowledge of the operation and routine maintenance of various light to heavy motorized vehicles and equipment.
- Knowledge of the principles, practices, techniques and methods of general, bridge and road construction, repair and maintenance.
- Knowledge of field surveying techniques and equipment.
- Knowledge of County policies, procedures, rules and regulations.
- Skill in operating light to heavy motorized vehicles and equipment.
- Skill in reading and interpreting road and/or bridge plans.
- Skill in providing effective work direction and instruction to work crews.

- Skill in following and effectively communicating verbal and written instructions.
- Skill in working independently or as a team member.

Education, Experience, Certifications and Licenses:

- High School diploma or equivalent GED certificate.
- Five years of experience in heavy equipment and vehicle operation.
- Possession of a valid State of Nevada Class A Commercial Driver's License with endorsements.
- Flagger certification.
- Forklift operator certification.

Environmental Factors and Conditions/Physical Requirements:

- Work is performed in internal and external environments with exposure to inclement weather, and varying temperatures.
- May be exposed to hazardous chemicals.
- Subject to standing, walking, sitting, bending, reaching, kneeling and lifting heavy objects over 100 pounds.
