This year's tournaments include the double elimination 26th Annual Nevada State Championship Tournament and the single elimination consolation Cantaloupe Festival Tournament. All teams begin in the Nevada State Championship Tournament. Teams who win at least one of their first two matches continue playing in the State Tournament. Teams who lose their first two matches in the State Tournament are placed in the Cantaloupe Festival Single Elimination Consolation Tournament.

Coed Mud Volleyball Rules

Cantaloupe Festival & Nevada State Championship

- 1. The first and most important rule in both tournaments is to have FUN! How seriously should mud volleyball be taken anyway!!?!?!
- 2. Absolutely, <u>NO</u> glass containers allowed in the mud volleyball area for everyone's safety, please!
- 3. The Nevada State Tournament will be double elimination with cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams. The Cantaloupe Festival Tournament will be single elimination with prizes for 1st place.
- 4. Coed Mud Volleyball consists of three men and three women. If you have to play with four, it *MUST* be two men and two women.
- 5. Games are to fifteen points, win by two. The best out of three games wins the match. A coin flip will determine the first serve.
- 6. Each team member will be required to sign a waiver form prior to playing. These forms will be available at the Mud Volleyball tournament table. You **cannot** enter a pit without a signed waiver on file.
- 7. All substitutions will be made at the middle back position.
- 8. The ball is in, if it touches water/mud contained in the pit.
- 9. Players may not go outside the pit to play the ball.
- 10. If teams do not have their players ready to go at the scheduled starting times, a ten-minute forfeit rule will be enforced.
- 11. If the ball is played with three touches, one **MUST** be by a woman. If there are one or two hits, any gender may play the ball.
- 12. Officials will call obvious carries. <u>HINT</u> to avoid problems, it is suggested to NOT use open hand underhand contact.
- 13. Overhand serves will not be allowed in the Cantaloupe Festival Tournament.
- 14. Officials will be provided.
- 15. Shoes are required.
- 16. Diving into the pits **IS NOT** allowed!
- 17. (2) day passes for Cantaloupe Festival will be included in entry fee.

REMEMBER: The entry deadline is: <u>Friday, August 29, 2014, at 4:00 p.m.</u> Late entries will NOT be accepted. Space is limited to 24 teams and entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. **Save money and register before August 21**st!

Teams who lose their first two matches in the State Tourney are placed in the Cantaloupe Festival Single Elimination Consolation Tournament. Every team is guaranteed 3 games!
- An equal number of men & women must participate at all times, 3 men 3 women; or 2 men 2 women.
- At least one woman must touch the ball before it is returned to the opponents.
- All entrants will be required to sign a release form before participating. Participants under 18 years of age, must have a parent or legal quardian sign the release form.
- Team captains are encouraged to pick up an explanation of the rules PRIOR to entering the event.

Sports Player Code of Conduct

- 1. NO PLAYER SHALL: at any time lay a hand upon, shove, strike or threaten an official. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report to League Director. Such player shall remain suspended until his case has been considered by the League Director.
- 2. NO PLAYER SHALL: refuse to abide by official's decision. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the League Director. Such player shall remain suspended until the case has been considered by the League Director.
- NO PLAYER SHALL: be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at official's decision.
- 4. NO PLAYER SHALL: discuss with an official, in any manner, the decision reached by such official except the manager or captain.
- 5. NO PLAYER SHALL: be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the lay of the game against the body and person of an opposing player. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the League Director.
- 6. NO PLAYER SHALL: be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor upon any player, official or spectator. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the League Director. Such player shall remain suspended until the case has been considered by the League Director.
- 7. NO PLAYER SHALL: be guilty of an abusive verbal attack upon any player, official or spectator. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the League Director. Such player shall remain suspended until the case has been considered by the League Director.
- 8. NO PLAYER SHALL: appear upon the field of play at any time in an intoxicated condition. Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the League Director. Such player shall remain suspended until the case has been considered by the League Director.

The <u>MINIMUM</u> penalty for infraction of any of the above rules shall be suspension from two League games. The <u>MAXIMUM</u> penalty for infraction will be removal from the Churchill Athletic Programs for life and/or assault charges filed.
